HALT BLEEDING BY POPE; FEARS FOR LIFE EASE

One of His 3 Doctors Quits Rome for Home

right about to crack, the pope bowed attentively in his room and asked that the bleeding be extended to appear anywhere in the world who cares to receive it.

The pope sent out word today that he is grateful to be the recipient of a million messages. He commented that he is a "feeling" man and that he is not used to the many, many sick people who write to him in his hospital or homes and also to those who are otherwise distressed.

The pope said that the flood of messages had strengthened his clear conviction that the life here is a gift, a gift from God, and that it is really valuable things in life are kindness, goodness and charity.

Official messages between the pope and President Kennedy passed through the office of Archbishop Eugenio Tardini, apostolic delegate to the United States. The United States has had no full-fledged diplomat at the Vatican since the death of the late William W. Taylor.

The United States did not recall its ambassador in 1959 but sent a half when Congress passed the law. This time the recall was permanent.

Overseer U. S. Post Archbishop Vigano was appointed by Pope John in 1956 to succeed Ambrogio Damiano Achilli, who had been made a cardinal and now is Pope John's secretary of state.

The story is told that Archbishop Vigano, who was assigned to Washington, said to Pope John: "But such an important duty, father? Can I do it?"

"What about me?" said the pope, who was himself newly elected.

The archbishop objected no more. From the messages many from Protestants, which have been received by Pope John since his current illness and within the Vatican limited out one written as a peace and an Italian soldier. The soldier is on a military pilgrimage to the shrine of Lourdes, in France, popular with persons seeking to recover health.

"All We Brothers" He wrote: "May the Virgin give you a prompt recovery so that you may for many years fulfill your holy mission. If you could be with us, you would see how 50,000 soldiers from many countries have flocked to follow your example, peace on earth. All men, black and white, are brothers."

President Kennedy has not issued a public statement since June 27. They were issued earlier in the week. He would be the third President to call at the Vatican while in office.

Archbishop Vigano, who had been in Rome since the death of Pope John, is expected to be named as the new apostolic delegate to the United States.
