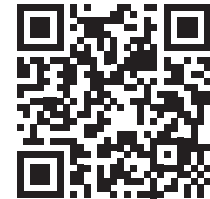

NEW COASTAL ENGINEERING CONDITION STUDY SHOWS HISTORIC LIMESTONE REVETMENT CAN BE SAVED AT PROMONTORY POINT, BURNHAM PARK, CHICAGO

Promontory Point Conservancy will be releasing its coastal engineers' condition study of Promontory Point's historic limestone revetment that demonstrates that the revetment functions satisfactorily as storm damage and shoreline protection right now, can be retained and repaired, and, if repaired and maintained, has another 86 - or more - years of service.
